Speed Hump Survey

Dewey Avenue: Oakton Street to Main Street

April 13, 2021

A petition was submitted to Alderman Cicely Fleming and the Public Works Agency requesting the placement of speed humps on Dewey Avenue between Oakton Street and Main Street. The neighborhood residents expressed concerns regarding speed issues and the desire to slow it down for safety children and residents that walk and bike in the area.

Following up on the request, the City conducted a post card survey to determine whether neighborhood residents were interested in installing speed humps on their block to address the concerns expressed in the petition. The block by block results of the survey are shown on the back side of this newsletter.

Based on the responses and the response rates, speed humps have been approved for three blocks on Dewey Avenue as follows:

- Between Oakton Street and South Blvd
- Between Keeney Street and Seward Street
- Between Madison Street and Washington Street

The speed humps on these blocks will be installed following the water main construction work on Dewey Avenue scheduled for Summer, 2021.
